


The Plaintiff shall execute a quitclaim deed conveying all her right, title, and interest in the subject property to the Defendant. However, should she fail to do so, this Order shall operate as a conveyance of Plaintiff's interest in the property to the Defendant and shall be recorded by the Clerk of the Court in the real estate records, maintained by her office as evidence of the conveyance.

The Defendant shall be entitled to retain the contents of the marital residence.

Defendant shall be entitled to retain all right, title, interest, and control in the business known as Old South Enterprises.


The Georgia Federal Credit Union savings and checking accounts (Account No. 445150) are awarded to the Defendant. The Plaintiff's name shall be removed from these accounts and she shall hereafter have no authority to transact any business relating thereto.
